### FERPA (Privacy Act)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal privacy law that affords parents the right to have access to their children's education records, seek to have the records amended, and consent to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from education records, except as provided by law.

By completing and returning this document, I am authorizing the Coeur d'Alene Tribe's Department of Education to access Lakeside School reports or records of my son/daughter in order to establish a plan for academic success. I understand that this information is considered a student education record. Further, I understand that by signing this release, I am waiving my right to keep this information confidential under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and that the information will be used confidentially by DOE staff to support educational success of my child. I certify that my consent for disclosure of this information is entirely voluntary. I understand this consent for disclosure of information can be revoked by me in writing at any time, but will not affect the information released under my previous consent.
