



KEITH & FLORENCE WILSON SCHOLARSHIP - 2017

1. INTRODUCTION AND ELIGIBILITY

Thank you for taking the time to apply for the Keith and Florence Wilson Scholarship offered by Lakeside High School. Keith and Florence Wilson farmed for many years in our area. Keith was a member of the 71st Army Infantry and a graduate of Lakeside High School in 1940. They have gifted money to our High School to provide scholarship opportunities for Lakeside graduates. You must complete all sections and include the required documentation in order to be considered for this scholarship.

Once complete, please submit your application and required documents to Stefani Hoffman by **April 1, 2017** .

To be eligible for this scholarship you must be a current graduating senior or past graduate of Lakeside High School, have a high school cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 or a college cumulative GPA of at least a 2.0 and you must be attending an **accredited** post-secondary institution in the fall, pursuing an undergraduate or advanced degree. A student may reapply for this scholarship each year.

Scholarships will be awarded based on academic performance, high school activities, leadership, community involvement, and volunteer community service hours. The scholarship monies will be sent to the post-secondary institution to be disbursed with the student's financial aid package. For current high school graduates, the money will be dispersed in the spring semester providing the student maintains enrollment and at least a 2.0 GPA in the fall. Continuing post-secondary students must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA. The funds will be dispersed half for the fall semester and half for the spring semester.

2. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Completed Application.
- An official copy of high school transcript or for undergraduate students, an official copy of college transcript.
- ACT, SAT or Compass Test Scores.
- 2 letters of recommendation, including one professional reference who is not related and does not work at for the Plummer-Worley School District.
- 500 word essay describing an experience which has had an impact on you, what you contributed, what you learned about yourself, and how it has influenced your plans for your education and your future. The essay must be typed, dated and signed.
