Plummer/Worley SD #44 is preparing to launch a back pack pilot program at the Elementary School level. We are always looking for ways to help our students and families. This program is another opportunity to help provide food security for students.

If you have unmet food needs for your family please contact our School Counselor, Lee Thomas, at 208-686-2132 to participate in the back pack program. There are no requirements other than a need so no questions will be asked and discretion will always be used.

What is the back pack program?

During the weekends families may struggle when school meal options are closed. The back pack program will help bridge this issue by discreetly sending your child home with a few shelf stable meal options they can use during the weekend. The process will be discreet and back packs are actually plastic grocery sacks placed into the child's own back pack to be taken home every Friday.

This program is free to our students and families and is possible through a collaborative partnership between the Coeur d'Alene Back Pack Program and the Plummer/Worley SD.
